

# Words to describe assistance and support

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# Part 01 - Basic Words to Express Assistance and Support

## 1. Help

- **Definition:** To provide what is necessary for someone to achieve or do something.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should offer help to others in times of need, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever relieves a believer's distress, Allah will relieve him of one of his distresses on the Day of Judgment." (Sahih Muslim)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** ددم (Madad)
    - *Example (Urdu):* "ایامرف ن ملسو ےلع لال ےلص دمحم ترضح" "اگ رک رود مغ اک ناملسم ےسک" "اگ"
    - (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo kisi musalman ka gham door karega, Allah Qiyamat ke din uske gham ko door karega.")*
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should help others in their distress, and in return, Allah will help them in the Hereafter.
  - **Arabic:** مدد (Musa'ada)
    - *Example (Arabic):* "ن ع ففخي نم: ملسو ےلع لال ےلص ےل بن لاق" "ةمايقلل موي ےف هنع لال ففخي، نمؤم"
    - (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man yukhaffif 'an mu'min, yukhaffif Allah 'anhu fi yawm al-qiyama.')*
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should offer help, as Allah will lighten their burdens on the Day of Judgment.
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## 2. Aid

- **Definition:** Assistance given to help someone or something, often in times of need.
- **Example:**

*The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The best of people are those who are most beneficial to others." (Daraqutni)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** دادم (Imdaad)
  - *Example (Urdu):* "اگر کسی کو دوسروں کی مدد کرنے کی ضرورت ہو، تو اس کی مدد کرنا چاہئے۔" (Jo shakhs doosron ki madad karta hai, Allah uski madad karta hai, jaisay ke Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: 'Sab se behtareen log woh hain jo doosron ko faida pohanchate hain.')
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should offer aid to others, as it brings Allah's blessings.
- **Arabic:** إنا عا (I'ana)
  - *Example (Arabic):* "أفضل الناس من سألهم عن حاجتهم." (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Afdal al-nas anfa'uhum lil-nas.')
  - **Meaning:** The best of people are those who aid others.

### 3. Support

- **Definition:** To bear the weight of or assist someone, often emotionally or physically.
- **Example:**

*A Muslim should support others, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "He who helps his brother in need, Allah will help him in his time of need." (Sahih Bukhari)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** تیمات (Himayat)
  - *Example (Urdu):* "ایامرف ن ملسو یلع لال یل ص دمحم ترضح"

*(Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo apne bhai ki madad karta hai, Allah Qiyamat ke din uski madad karega.")*
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should support others, and in return, Allah will support them on the Day of Judgment.
  - **Arabic:** مدع (Da'am)

- **Example (Arabic):** "من اسرني نم: ملسو هيلع هلل ىلص يبنن لاق" "هتجاح موي في هلل هدناسي، ةجاح في هأ" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man yusanid akhahu fi hajah, yusaniduhu Allah fi yawm hajatih.')
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should support their brother or sister, as Allah will support them in their time of need.
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## 4. Assistance

- **Definition:** The action of helping someone by providing support or resources.

- **Example:**

The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever assists a believer in a time of difficulty, Allah will assist them in this world and the Hereafter." (Sahih Muslim)

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** ددم (Madad)
    - **Example (Urdu):** "اىامرف ن ملسو ىلعل للا ىلص دمحم ترضح" "اترك دم ىك سا للا، اترك دم ىك ناملسم ىسك" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo kisi musalman ki madad karta hai, Allah uski madad karta hai.")
    - **Meaning:** A Muslim should assist others, and Allah will assist them in return.
  - **Arabic:** مدعاسم (Musa'ada)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "دعاسي نم: ملسو هيلع هلل ىلص يبنن لاق" "ةخال او ايندل في هلل مدعاسي، هتجاح تقو في املسم" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man yusa'id muslima fi waqt hajati, yusa'iduhu Allah fi al-dunya wa al-akhira.')
    - **Meaning:** A Muslim should assist others, and Allah will assist them in both this world and the Hereafter.
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## 5. Encourage

- **Definition:** To give someone confidence or support to do something.

- **Example:**

A Muslim should encourage others in doing good, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever encourages someone to do good, it is as if they have done it themselves." (Sahih Muslim)

- **Meaning:** A Muslim should guide others to righteousness, as Allah commands cooperation in piety.

## 7. Serve

- **Definition:** To perform duties for someone or provide assistance in a helpful manner.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should serve others as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The most beloved of people to Allah are those who are most beneficial to others."*  
(Sahih Bukhari)

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** خدمت (Khidmat)

- **Example (Urdu):** "ای امام رفیق ملسو یرلعل لال یرل ص دمحم ترضح" تم دځ ډایز س بس ی ک ورسود وچ یی و گول بوبحم س بس کی دزن یی ترک"

(Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Allah ke nazdeek sab se mehboob log woh hain jo doosron ki sab se zyada khidmat karte hain.")

- **Meaning:** A Muslim should serve others, as service to others is beloved to Allah.

- **Arabic:** خدمة (Khidma)

- **Example (Arabic):** "سانل لبأ: ملسو هیرلعل لال یرل ص ی بنل لاق" سانل لمه عف نأ لال یرلإ"

(Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Ahabbu al-nas ila Allah anfa'uhum lil-nas.')

- **Meaning:** The most beloved of people to Allah are those who benefit others the most.

# Part 02 - Intermediate words for Assistance and Support

## 1. Assist

- **Definition:** To help or give support to someone in performing a task or achieving something.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should assist others in their time of need, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Help your brother, whether he is an oppressor or he is oppressed." (Sahih Bukhari)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** انرک ددم (Madad Karna)
    - **Example (Urdu):** "ای امرف ن ملسو یل لال یل ص دمحم ترضح" "مولظم ای و ملاظ و اوچ، ورک ددم ی ک یئ اھب"  
(Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Apne bhai ki madad karo, chahe woh zalim ho ya mazloom.")
    - **Meaning:** A Muslim should assist others, as the Prophet (PBUH) taught that we should help each other in all circumstances.
  - **Arabic:** مدعاسم (Musa'ada)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "كأخأ دعاس': ملسو هیلع هلال یل ص ی بن ل لاق" "امولظم وأاملاظ ناكءاوس"  
(Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Sa'id akhak, sawaya kana zaliman aw mazluman.'))
    - **Meaning:** A Muslim should assist others in their need, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) instructed.
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## 2. Facilitate

- **Definition:** To make a process or task easier by providing assistance or removing obstacles.

- **Example:**

Allah commands in the Quran, "Indeed, Allah will make ease for those who help others." (Quran 94:6)

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** آسان بنانا (Aasaan Banana)
    - **Example (Urdu):** "ہم نے آپ کی سہولت کے لیے آسان بنانا ہے۔" (Allah Ta'ala Quran mein farmate hain: "Allah un logon ke liye aasani paida karta hai jo doosron ki madad karte hain.")
    - **Meaning:** Allah makes tasks easier for those who help others.
  - **Arabic:** تسهيل (Tashil)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "يُذِلُّ اللَّهُ لِمَنْ يَشَاءُ سُبُلَ الْيُسْرِ وَالْيُسْرَى." (Qala Allah Ta'ala: "Inna Allah yusahhil al-umur lil-ladhina yusa'idun al-akhareen.")
    - **Meaning:** Allah will ease the way for those who facilitate the tasks of others.
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### 3. Encourage

- **Definition:** To give support, confidence, or hope to someone to help them pursue or continue an activity.

- **Example:**

The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever encourages someone to do good, it is as if they have done it themselves." (Sahih Muslim)

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** اُسارنا (Hosla Afzai Karna)
  - **Example (Urdu):** "جو شخص کسی کو اچھا کرنے کی ترغیب دے گا، گویا وہ خود ہی اچھا کرے گا۔" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo kisi ko achha karne ki hosla afzai karta hai, goya us ne khud woh kaam kiya.")
  - **Meaning:** Encouraging others to do good deeds brings reward, as if you did the good yourself.
- **Arabic:** تشجيع (Tashji)
  - **Example (Arabic):** "مَنْ شَجَّاهُ إِلَىٰ طَيْرٍ طَيِّبٍ، فَكَأَنَّهُ شَجَّاهُ إِلَىٰ طَيْرٍ طَيِّبٍ." (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): "Man shajja'a ahadan 'ala al-khayr, faka'annah



*fa'alah.'*)

- **Meaning:** Encouraging others to do good is like doing it yourself, according to the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH).

## 4. Champion

- **Definition:** To support or defend someone or something, often in a public or strong manner.
- **Example:**

*The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) was a champion for the rights of the oppressed, as he said, "Whoever helps the oppressed, Allah will help him."*  
(Sunan Abu Dawood)

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** ان بنی ماح (Hami Banna)
  - *Example (Urdu):* "ای امرف بن ملسو یلع لال یل ص دمحم ترضح"  
"اترک دم یک سا لال، اترک دم یک مولظم"  
(Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo mazloom ki madad karta hai, Allah uski madad karta hai.")
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should champion the rights of the oppressed, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) advocated for them.
- **Arabic:** عافدلا (Al-Difa')
  - *Example (Arabic):* "رصاني نم: ملسو هيلع هلال یل ص ی بنی لاق"  
"هلل ه رصان، مولظم ال"  
(Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man yunassir al-mazloom, nasaraahu Allah.')"
  - **Meaning:** Supporting and defending the oppressed is a duty for Muslims, and Allah will support those who do.

## 5. Promote

- **Definition:** To support or actively encourage the growth or development of something.
- **Example:**

*The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever calls others to good, they will receive the reward of those who follow them." (Sahih Muslim)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** انی د غورف (Farog Dena)

- **Example (Urdu):** "ایامرف ن ملسو ىلع لال ىلص دمحم ترضح": "اگ ىاپ باوٹ اک سولم عك نا و، اتالب فرط ىك ىئاهچا وك سورسود" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo doosron ko achai ki taraf bulata hai, woh unke a'malon ka sawab paayega.")
  - **Meaning:** Promoting goodness and encouraging others to follow the right path brings rewards.
  - **Arabic:** ج ي و ر ت ل ا (Al-Tarwīj)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "ىلإ اعد نم': ملسو هىلع هللا ىلص ىب ن ل ا ل ا ق": "ه ب لم ع نم ر ج ا ل ث م ه ل ف ، ر ي خ ل ا" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man da'a ila al-khayr, falahu mithl ajr man 'amila bihi.')
    - **Meaning:** Promoting goodness and helping others to do good deeds will earn the same reward as if you did it yourself.
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## 6. Uplift

- **Definition:** To raise someone's mood or status, offering encouragement or support.
  - **Example:**  
The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Smiling in the face of your brother is charity." (Sahih Bukhari)
  - **Synonyms:**
    - **Urdu:** انرک ىئازفا ل ص و ح (Hosla Afzai Karna)
      - **Example (Urdu):** "انپا': اىامرف ن ملسو ىلع لال ىلص دمحم ترضح": "ق د ص انارک سم ن م اس ک ىئاهب" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Apne bhai ke samne muskurana sadaqa hai.")
      - **Meaning:** Uplifting others through kindness, such as smiling, is a form of charity and encouragement.
    - **Arabic:** ر ا ف ر (Rafa')
      - **Example (Arabic):** "ك ت م اس ت ب ا': ملسو هىلع هللا ىلص ىب ن ل ا ل ا ق": "ة ق د ص ك ي خ ا ه ج و ي ف" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Ibtisamatuka fi wajhi akhika sadaqa.')
      - **Meaning:** Uplifting someone with kindness and good intentions is considered a charitable act.
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## 7. Bolster

- **Definition:** To strengthen or support something, often improving its effectiveness.

- **Example:**

*The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The strong believer is better and more beloved to Allah than the weak believer, while there is good in both." (Sahih Muslim)*

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** ان رک طوبضم (Mazboot Karna)
  - Example (Urdu): "ایامرف ن ملسو یلع لیل یل ص دمحم ترضح"  
 "ر ب س ن موم روزمک ن موم طوبضم"  
 (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Mazboot mo'min kamzor mo'min se behtar hai.")
  - **Meaning:** A Muslim should strengthen their faith and character, as the strong believer is loved by Allah.
- **Arabic:** زي زعت (Ta'zeez)
  - Example (Arabic): "یوقل نمؤمل ا: ملسو وه یلع هل یل ص ی بنل لاق"  
 "فیعضلل نمؤمل نم هل یل لبأ وریخ"  
 (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Al-mu'min al-qawi khayr wa ahabb ila Allah min al-mu'min al-da'if.'))
  - **Meaning:** Strengthening oneself in faith and actions is a virtue that Allah loves.

## 8. Strengthen

- **Definition:** To make something or someone stronger or more resilient.

- **Example:**

*The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Verily, with hardship comes ease."*  
(Quran 94:6)

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** انرک طوبضم (Mazboot Karna)
- *Example (Urdu):* "ایامرف ن ملسو یلع لیل ص دمحم ترضح"  
 "ی ناس آ دع ب ک لک شم ر"  
 (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Yaqeeman har mushkil ke baad asani hai.")

- **Meaning:** Through trials and hardships, Allah strengthens the believer.
  - **Arabic:** تقيوة (Taqwiya)
    - *Example (Arabic):* "إِرسِي رَسْعَالَا عَم نِإْ: يَلَاعَت هَلَلَا لَاق" (Qala Allah Ta'ala: "Inna ma'a al-usri yusra.")
    - **Meaning:** Allah strengthens the believer through challenges, as ease follows hardship.
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## 9. Subsidize

- **Definition:** To support financially, usually by a government or organization.
- **Example:**

*Allah promises to support the needy, as stated in the Quran, "Indeed, Allah is the Provider." (Quran 51:58)*

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** انیدی ڈسبس (Subsidy Dena)
    - *Example (Urdu):* "قزر لال انی قی: یں ت امر ف یں م ن آرق ی لاعت لال" (Allah Ta'ala Quran mein farmate hain: "Yaqeeman Allah rizq dene wala hai.")
    - **Meaning:** Allah financially supports the needy and provides sustenance.
  - **Arabic:** مدد (Da'am)
    - *Example (Arabic):* "قازر لآ وه ه ل ل ن إ: ی لَاعَت ه ل ل لَاق" (Qala Allah Ta'ala: "Inna Allah huwa al-Razzaq.")
    - **Meaning:** Allah is the ultimate provider and sustainer for all.
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## 10. Reinforce

- **Definition:** To strengthen or support something further, often by adding more resources or effort.
- **Example:**

*The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The believer to another believer is like a strong building, each part supporting the other." (Sahih Bukhari)*

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** انرک مکحتسم (Mustahkam Karna)

- *Example (Urdu):* "ایامرف ن ملسو ےلے لال ےل ص دمحم ترضح"  
 "ہرط ےک ترامع طوبضم کی ےل ےک نموم ےرسود"  
 (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Mo'min doosray mo'min ke liye aik mazboot imarat ki tarah hai.")
- **Meaning:** Reinforcing the unity of the believers strengthens the community.
- **Arabic:** زي زعت (Ta'zeez)
- *Example (Arabic):* "ن مؤملا: ملسو ےلے لال ےل ص ےل بن لال اق"  
 "اضع ب هضع ب دشي ناي بن لال اك نمؤملل"  
 (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Al-mu'min lil-mu'min kal-bunyan yashudd ba'duh ba'dan.')
- **Meaning:** Strengthening the bonds among Muslims makes the entire community stronger.

# Part 03 - Advance words for Assistance and Support

## 1. Alleviate

- **Definition:** To make a situation or pain less severe or more bearable.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should strive to alleviate the suffering of others, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever relieves a believer's distress, Allah will relieve him of one of his distresses on the Day of Judgment." (Sahih Muslim)*

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** انرک مک (Kam Karna)
    - **Example (Urdu):** "وَج: ایامرف ن ملسو یلع لال یل ص دمحم ترضح" "اگ رک مک مغ اک سا ند ک تمایق لال، اترک مک مغ اک ناملسم یسک" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo kisi musalman ka gham kam karta hai, Allah Qiyamat ke din uska gham kam karega.")
    - **Meaning:** A Muslim should alleviate the suffering of others, as Allah will alleviate their pain in the Hereafter.
  - **Arabic:** تخفیف (Takhfif)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "نعففخ نم: ملسو هیلع لال یل ص یبنل لاق" "ةمايقلل موي ي ف هنع هلال ففخ، نمؤم" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man khaffafa 'an mu'min, khaffafa Allah 'anhu fi yawm al-qiyama.')
    - **Meaning:** Alleviating someone's distress will result in Allah alleviating one's burdens on the Day of Judgment.
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## 2. Mitigate

- **Definition:** To make a situation less severe, harsh, or intense.

- **Example:**

*Muslims are encouraged to mitigate the hardships of others, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Whoever helps a person in difficulty, Allah will help*

*him in his time of difficulty."* (Sahih Muslim)

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** ان رک روزم (Kamzor Karna)
  - *Example (Urdu):* "ایامرف ن ملسو یل لیل ص دم ح ترضح" "اتیدی رک م ک تالک شم یک سا لیل، ات رک دم یک یسک"  
(Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo kisi ki madad karta hai, Allah uski mushkilat kam kar deta hai.")
  - **Meaning:** Helping others to mitigate their difficulties will result in Allah reducing your own difficulties.
- **Arabic:** فيخف (Takhfif)
  - *Example (Arabic):* "نع ففخي نم: ملسو هيلع ه ل ل ل ص ي ب ن ل ل اق" "ة ا ي ق ل ل موي ي ف ه ن ع ه ل ل ف فخي، ن مؤم"  
(Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Man yukhaffif 'an mu'min, yukhaffif Allah 'anhu fi yawm al-qiyama.')"
  - **Meaning:** Mitigating someone's hardships will result in Allah easing your difficulties.

### 3. Bolster

- **Definition:** To support, strengthen, or reinforce something, often with resources or encouragement.
- **Example:**

*A Muslim should bolster the efforts of others in good deeds, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The strong believer is better and more beloved to Allah than the weak believer." (Sahih Muslim)*

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** (Ta'qwiat Karna) انرک تیوقت
  - *Example (Urdu):* "ایامرف ن ملسو ےلے لے لے ص دم ترضح" "اترک دم یک سا لے لے، اترک دم یک ے رسود"  
(Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Jo doosray ki madad karta hai, Allah uski madad karta hai.")
  - **Meaning:** By bolstering others, you receive Allah's support and assistance.
- **Arabic:** (Ta'zeez) زیزعت
  - *Example (Arabic):* "ملسو ےلے لے لے ص ی بن لاق" "فیض ل نمؤم ل نم ےلے لے لے بح أو ریخ"  
(Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Al-mu'min al-qawi khayr wa ahabb ila Allah min al-mu'min al-da'if.')

- **Meaning:** Strengthening others in faith and deeds is highly encouraged in Islam.
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## 4. Empower

- **Definition:** To give someone the power, confidence, or authority to do something or take control.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should empower others through education and knowledge, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "Seeking knowledge is an obligation upon every Muslim." (Sunan Ibn Majah)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** انید ت قاط (Taqat Dena)
    - **Example (Urdu):** "ای امر ف ن ملسو یل ع ل ل ی لص دم ح م ت رض ح" "ض رف ر پ ن ام ل س م ر ل و ص ح" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Ilm ka husool har musalman par farz hai.")
    - **Meaning:** Empowering others with knowledge is a key principle in Islam.
  - **Arabic:** ن ی ک م ت (Tamkeen)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "م ل ع ل ا ب ل ط : م ل س و ه ی ل ع ل ل ی لص ی ب ن ل ل ا ق" "م ل س م ل ک ی ل ع ة ض ی ر ف" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Talab al-ilm faridah 'ala kulli muslim.'))
    - **Meaning:** Empowering others with knowledge is part of fulfilling the Islamic obligation of seeking knowledge.
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## 5. Foster

- **Definition:** To encourage the development or growth of something, often in a nurturing or supportive way.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should foster a sense of community and brotherhood, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "None of you will believe until you love for your brother what you love for yourself." (Sahih Bukhari)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** ان رک ش ر و ر پ (Parwarish Karna)



- **Example (Urdu):** "میں نے ایمان لایا ہے کہ اللہ تعالیٰ صدمہ نہ دے گا۔" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Tum mein se koi shakhs is waqt tak imaan nahi laya jab tak ke woh apne bhai ke liye wohi pasand na kare jo apne liye pasand karta hai.")
  - **Meaning:** Fostering love and care for others is a key element of faith.
  - **Arabic:** رِیَاة (Ri'aya)
    - **Example (Arabic):** "مَنْ يُؤْمِرْ بِالْعَمَلِ الصَّالِحِ يَنْجِبْهُ مِنَ الْكَبِيرِ." (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'La yu'minu ahadukum hatta yuhibbu li-akhihi ma yuhibbu linafsihi.')
    - **Meaning:** Fostering brotherhood and mutual love is central to the teachings of Islam.
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## 6. Sustain

- **Definition:** To maintain or keep something going over time, often by providing necessary support.
- **Example:** Muslims are encouraged to sustain their faith and good deeds, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The best deeds are those done consistently, even if they are small." (Sahih Bukhari)

### Synonyms:

- **Urdu:** برقرار رکھنا (Barqarar Rakhna)
  - **Example (Urdu):** "سب سے بہتر اعمال وہ ہیں جو مسلسل کیے جائیں، چاہے وہ کچھ ہی ہوں۔" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Sab se behtar amal woh hai jo mustamir tor par kiya jaye, chahe woh thoda hi kyun na ho.")
  - **Meaning:** Sustaining faith through consistent actions, no matter how small, is highly valued.
- **Arabic:** إدامة (Istidama)
  - **Example (Arabic):** "لَا تَقْنَطُوا مِنْ حِثِّ الصَّالِحِينَ." (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Afdal al-a'mal adwamuha wa in qal.')
  - **Meaning:** Sustaining good deeds, even if small, is more important than doing large deeds infrequently.

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## 7. Augment

- **Definition:** To increase or improve something, often by adding additional support or resources.

- **Example:**

*A Muslim should augment their good deeds, as the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said, "The best of deeds is to bring happiness to a believer." (Sahih Bukhari)*

**Synonyms:**

- **Urdu:** انرک ۛ فاضا (Izafa Karna)
  - **Example (Urdu):** "ایامرف ۛ نملسو ۛ یلع ۛ لال یلص دمحم ترضح" (Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) ne farmaya: "Sab se behtar amal woh hai jo kisi momin ko khushi de.")
  - **Meaning:** Augmenting the happiness of others is an important part of a Muslim's good deeds.
- **Arabic:** ۛدایز (Ziyadah)
  - **Example (Arabic):** "لضفأ: ملسو ۛ یلع ۛ لال یلص یبنل لاق" (Qala al-nabi (PBUH): 'Afdal al-a'mal idkhal al-surur 'ala al-mu'min.')"
  - **Meaning:** Augmenting the joy of others through acts of kindness is highly recommended in Islam.
